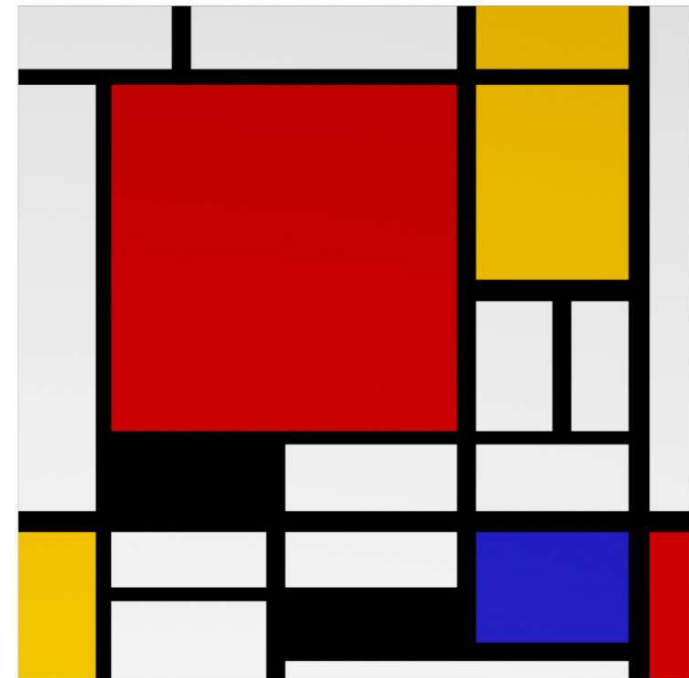


Contemporary Lamp Design

The Bauhaus was a German art & industry school that was opened by Walter Gropius in 1919 and operated until 1933. The professors of the school, along with their artworks & curriculums, would become highly influential in design during the following century that has nearly come to pass since its closure.

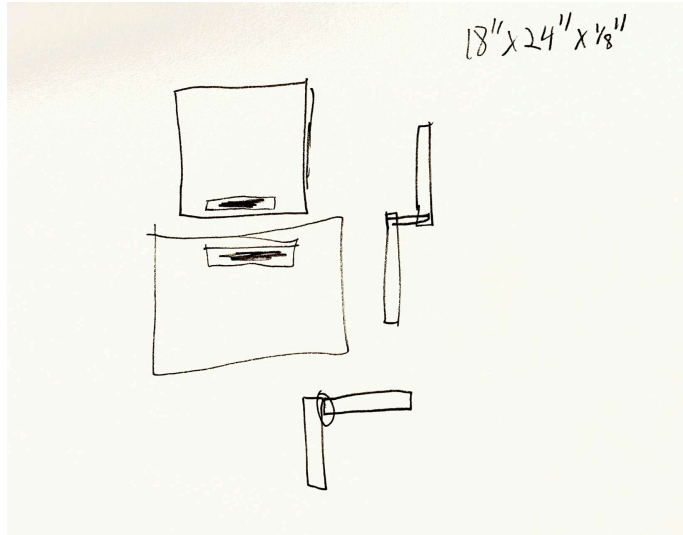

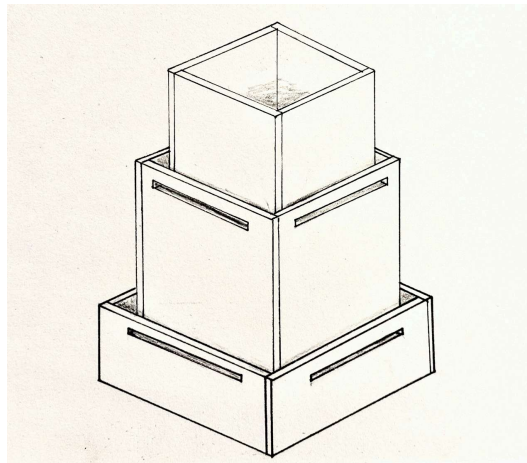

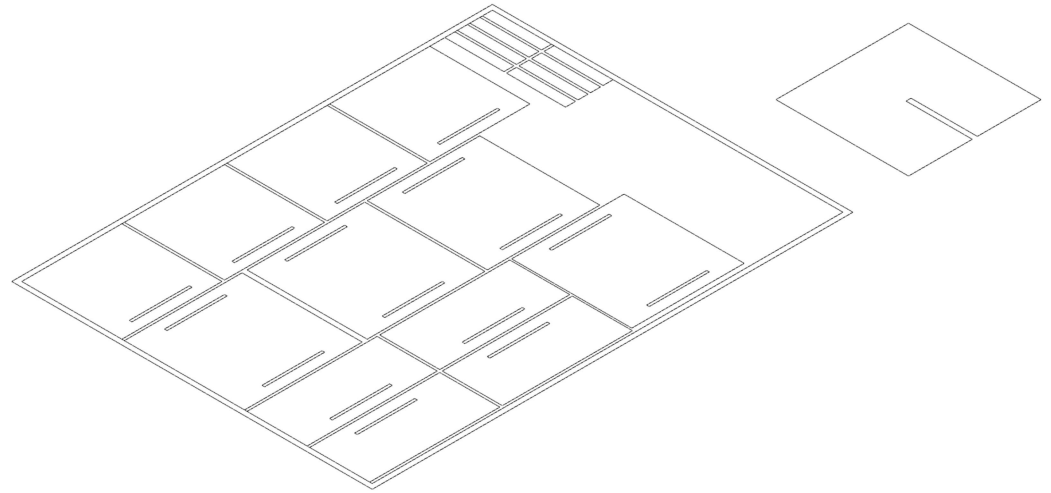

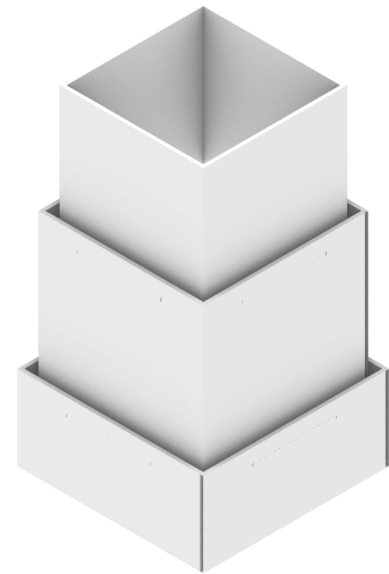
Concept Sketch



Isometric Parti

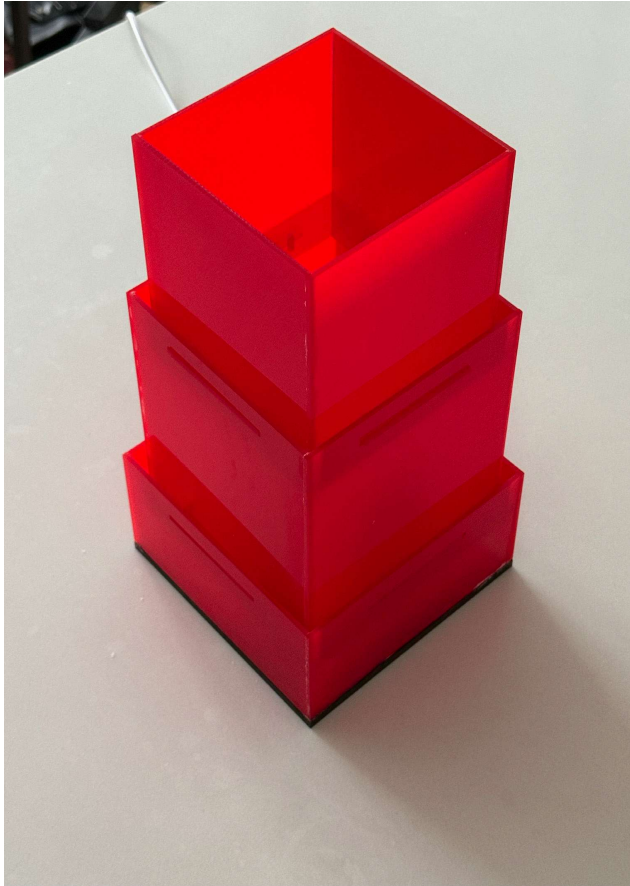


CNC Map



Isometric 3D Model Views

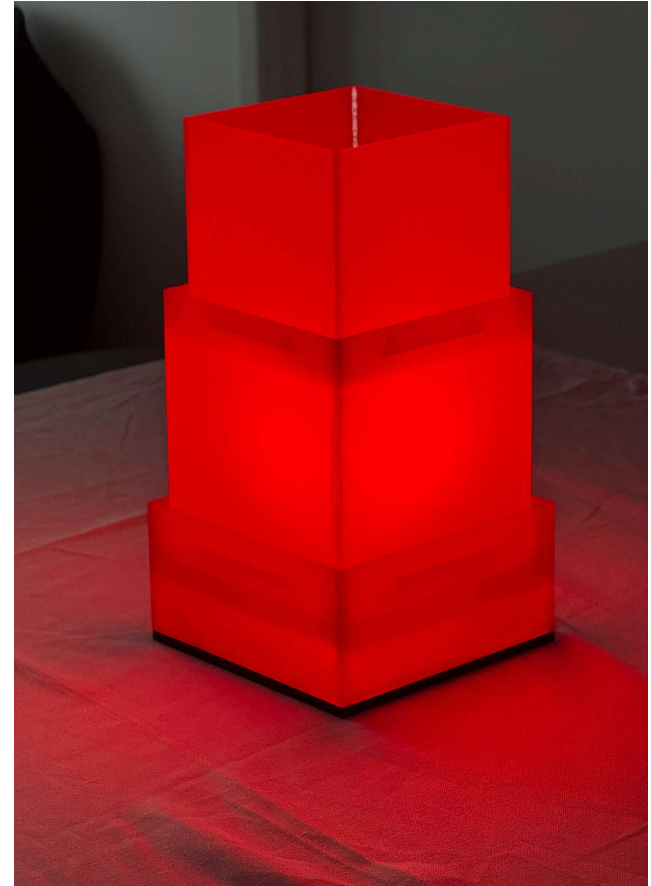
